Extension – Control Programming LLC- EnableDisable - Cloud
version 2.0.6

Extension

This release note is for the Crestron enable/disable extension. This driver is designed to act as a buffer between motion sensors and the lights being controlled. The motion sensor Occupied event would be wired to the enable/disable start trigger, which in turn would turn the lights on. The motion sensor Vacancy event would be wired to the enable/disable stop trigger, which would turn off the lights. If the enable/disable extension was disabled, the motion sensor triggers would be ignored.

The installer can now specify the icons for the enable/disable states as well as text.

Obtain License Key – clicking on the “CPLLC.net” link will take you to the website to purchase the necessary license. The obtained license key will need to be entered in the license manager on the appropriate SKU.

Show on Home Page – check if extension is to be visible on the home page.

Show in Room Page – checked if extension is visible in the room page.

Check to make Inverted – this is checked when you want the enable/disable to be shown inverted.

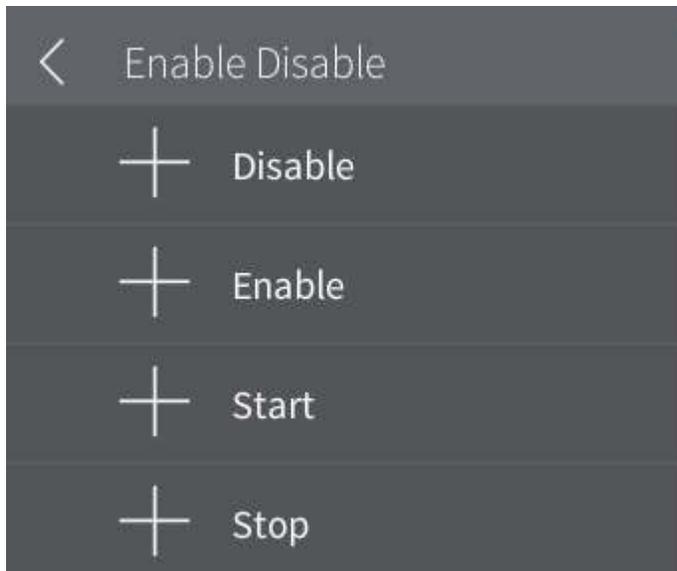
Enable State Icon – Icon to display when enabled. Valid icons can be found at the link on the first page.

Enable State Text – Text to display when enabled.

Disable State Icon – Icon to display when disabled.

Disable State Text – Text to display when disabled.

Actions



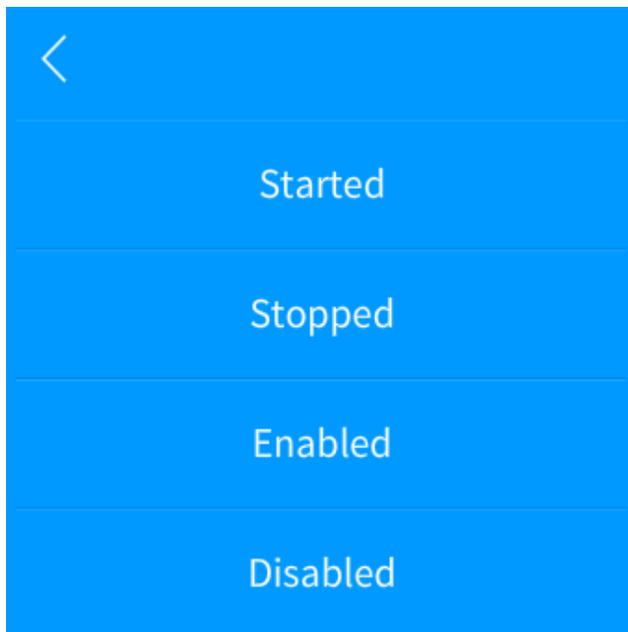
Disable – Used to disable the extension. Any Start/Stop triggers will be ignored.

Enable – Used to enable the extension. All Start/Stop triggers will be passed through.

Start – Triggered when something started.

Stop – Triggered when something stopped.

Events



Started – Event that is executed when the Start action has been triggered.

Stopped – Event that is executed when the Stop action has been triggered.

Enabled – Event that is executed when the Enable action has been triggered.

Disabled – Event that is executed when the Disable action has been triggered.

End-User Experience



Left screen shot shows the enabled status which the right screen shot shows the disabled status. As noted elsewhere, the extension will 100% function for two hours without a license key. After two hours the tile will show “Licensed Expired” if a valid license has not been entered.
