This release note is for the Crestron extension that manages the Hebrew Calendar by providing events for Shabbat Candle, Shabbat Havdalah, Holiday Shabbat, Holiday Havdalah, Pesach Candle, Sukkot Candle, and Sukkot Havdalah.

	<b>Shabbat Candle Offset</b> Shabbat Candle offset is the number of minutes before candle lighting to fire the event	<input type="text" value="0"/>
	<b>Shabbat Havdalah Offset</b> Shabbat Havdalah offset is the number of minutes after the emergence of three stars to fire the event	<input type="text" value="0"/>
	<b>Holiday Candle Offset</b> Holiday Candle offset is the number of minutes before candle lighting to fire the event	<input type="text" value="0"/>
	<b>Holiday Havdalah Offset</b> Holiday Havdalah offset is the number of minutes after the emergence of three stars to fire the event	<input type="text" value="0"/>

**Obtain License Key** – clicking on the “CPLLC.net” link will take you to the website to purchase the necessary license. The obtained license key will need to be entered in the license manager on the appropriate SKU.

**Show on Home Page** – check if extension is to be visible on the home page.

**Show in Room Page** – checked if extension is visible in the room page.

**Check to use Israel holiday schedules** – Indicates if Israel holiday schedules should be used

**Check to display Halachic times** – indicates a subset of Halachic times are to be displayed

**Check to display all Halachic times** – indicates that all Halachic times should be displayed

**Check to use Sephardic Transliterations** – Check if you want to use Sephardic transliterations. Unchecked will use Ashkenazis transliterations.

**Check to display Hebrew** – if checked Hebrew spellings will be displayed

**Check to use Zipcode** – if checked then the zipcode will be used for the house. Otherwise, the latitude/longitude/tz timezone will be used.

**Zipcode** – The house’s zip code which is used to determine Sunset and Sunrise times.

**Latitude** – Latitude of house’s location

**Longitude** – Longitude of house’s location

**Obtain Time Zone** – clicking will open the webpage that contains the TZ Database Time Zone spellings.

**TZ Database Time Zone** – Time zone which must be one of the strings from link on the previous page

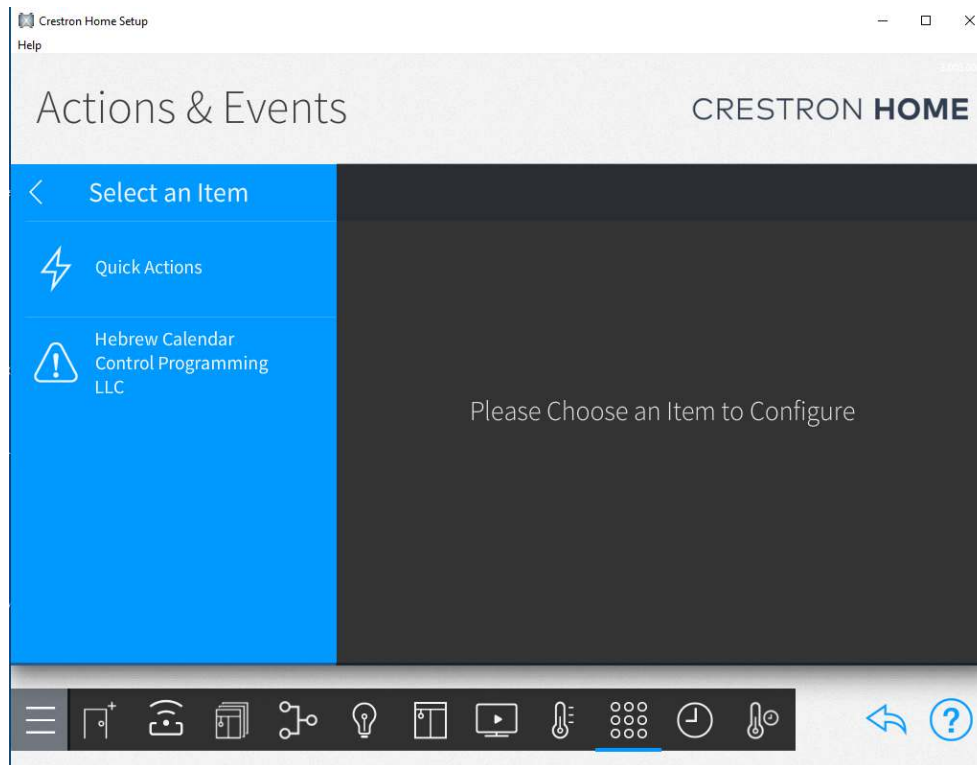
**Shabbat Candle Offset** – Number of minutes before candle lighting to trigger the event

**Shabbat Havdalah Offset** – Number of minutes after the emergence of the three stars to trigger the event

**Holiday Candle Offset** – Number of minutes before candle lighting to trigger the event – used for the Pesach and Sukkot Candle events

**Holiday Havdalah Offset** – Number of minutes after the emergence of three stars to trigger the event – used for the Sukkot Havdalah event.

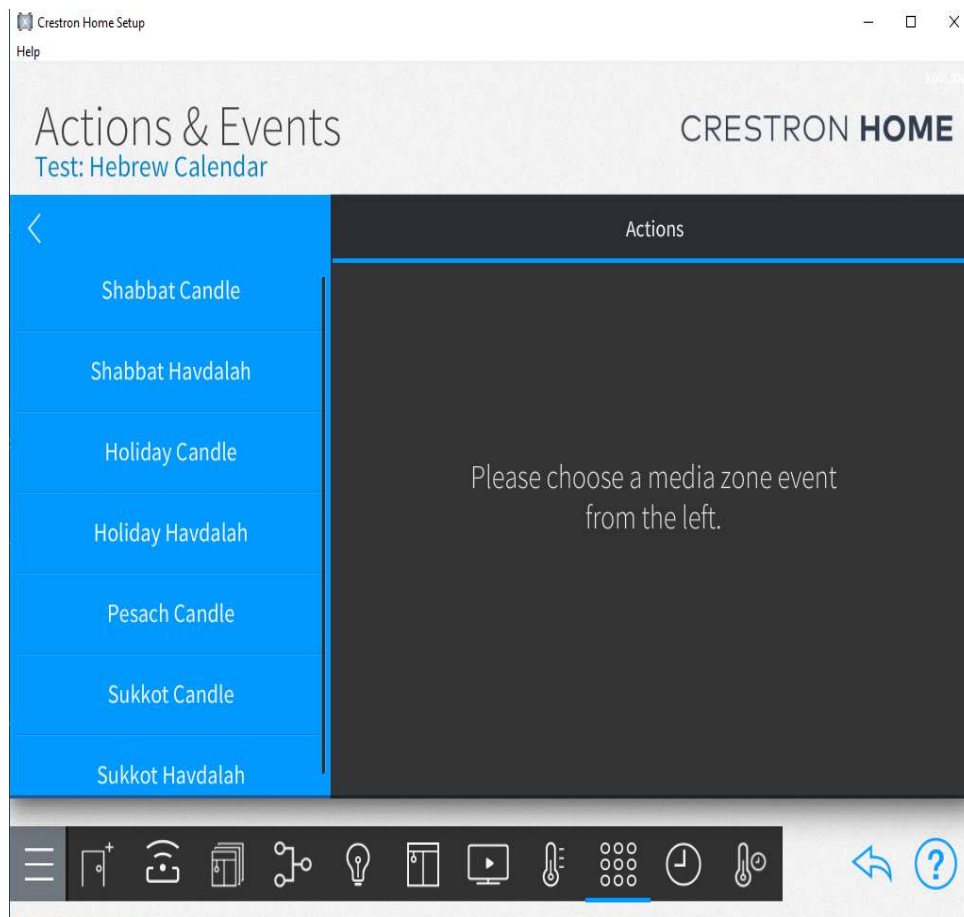
## Sequence Events



The Hebrew Calendar action would be selected.

Ignore the “triangle !” as that is an issue with Crestron Home.

## Sequence Event Triggers



**Shabbat Candle** – triggered on Friday at sundown adjusted by installer option

**Shabbat Havdalah** – triggered on Saturday after the emergence of three stars adjusted by the installer option

**Holiday Candle** – triggered on the holiday start at sundown adjusted by the installer option

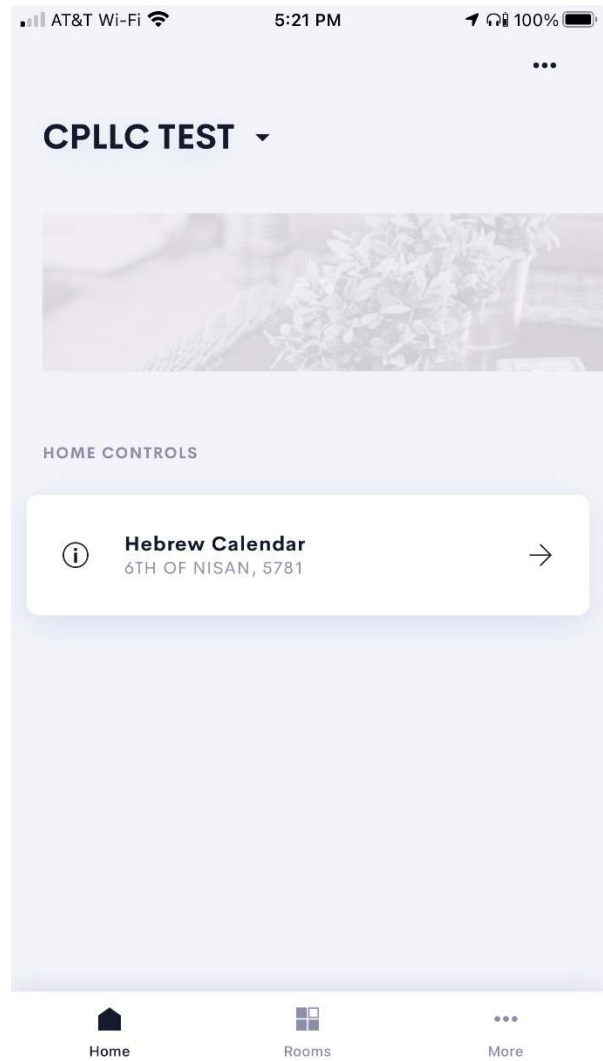
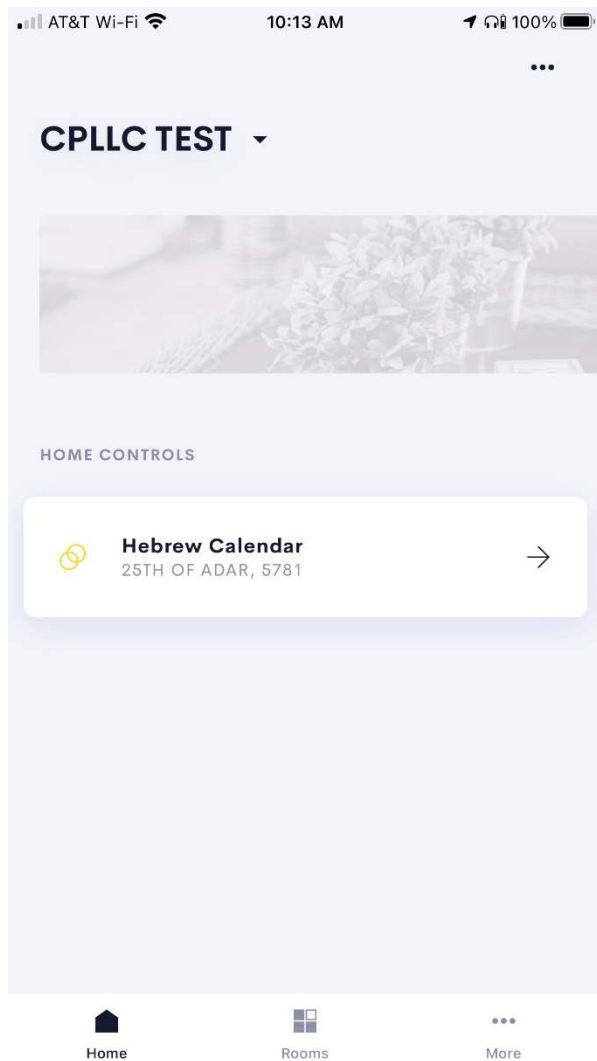
**Holiday Havdalah** – triggered on the holiday end after the emergence of three stars adjusted by the installer option

**Pesach Candle** – triggered first day of Pesach (Passover) adjusted by Holiday installer option

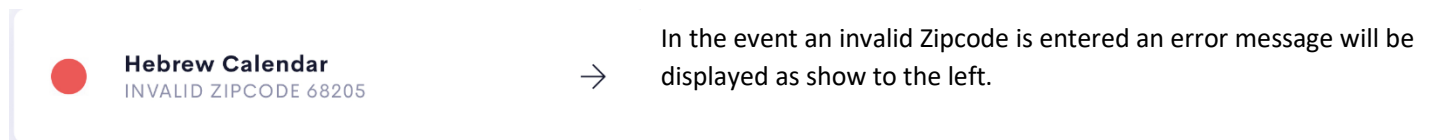
**Sukkot Candle** – triggered in addition to the Holiday Candle on Sukkot adjusted by Holiday installer option

**Sukkot Havdalah** – triggered in addition to the Holiday Havdalah on Simchat Torah adjusted by Holiday installer option.

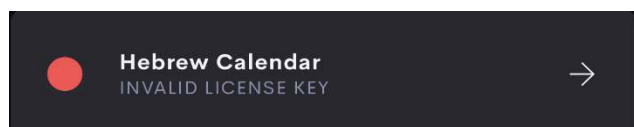
## End-User Experience



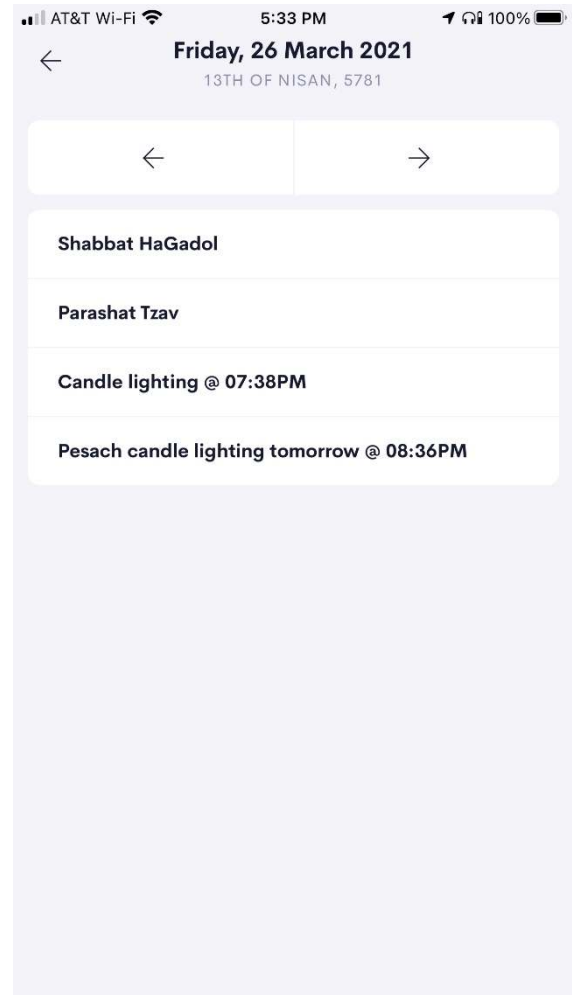
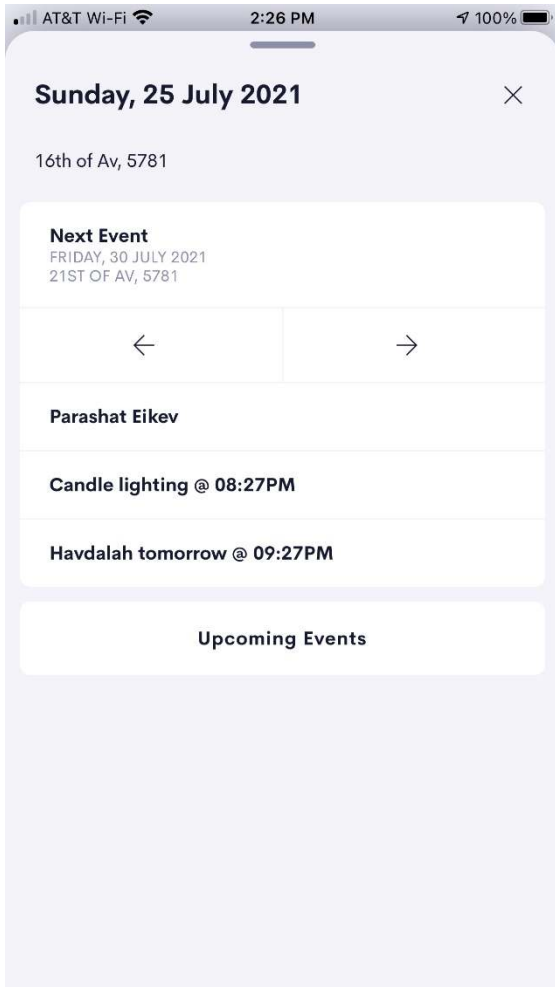
The above screen shots show the information that is displayed on the home screen. The left screen shot shows a normal day without any Shabbat or Holiday events. The right screen shot shows the information icon when additional information is available to view.



In the event an invalid Zipcode is entered an error message will be displayed as show to the left.



After 2 hours without a valid license key, the screen shot left will result letting the user know there is an invalid license key.



The above screen shots show additional information that is relevant to the specific date. Pressing the Upcoming Events will allow the end user to scroll through up to 3 months of special event dates by the using the right and left arrows in the right screen
