Installer Options

Obtains License Key – clicking on CPLLC.net will bring up the website from which license keys can be obtained.

Site License Key – place to insert the Site license if one is used

Visible on Home Page – checked if extension is displayed on home screen

Visible on Room Page – checked if extension is displayed on room screen

Notification Seconds – number of seconds between each SSDP beacon that informs the extensions/drivers where the license manager is located

License Manager Multicast Address – IP address being used for multicast

License Manager Multicast Port – Port number being used for multicast

End-User Experience



On the home/room page the license manager will provide feedback as to the license status of the extensions/driver. The green dot indicates all extensions/drivers are licensed. The red exclamation point indicates one or more extensions/drivers are not licensed. Touching the tile will bring up a list of installed extensions/drivers SKUs as well as their license status.



The above screen shows a list of installed CPLLC extensions/drivers sorted by their SKU. A green dot indicates licensed while a red dot indicates not licensed. Pressing the key button will display a page on which the key can be entered

License keys are sent via email looking like the following:

CPLLC.CPLLC.Site

00:10:7F:EB:D6:EF

699C-8FF0-94C6-D22F-FBBA-5DEB-84DD

The first line is the product SKU, the second line is the MAC address of the processor being licensed, and the last line is the License Key. Only the last line, License key, needs to be placed in the above text box complete with hyphens. Once entered click on save to save it.

Should an invalid key be entered an error message will be displayed below the entered key.
