Extension

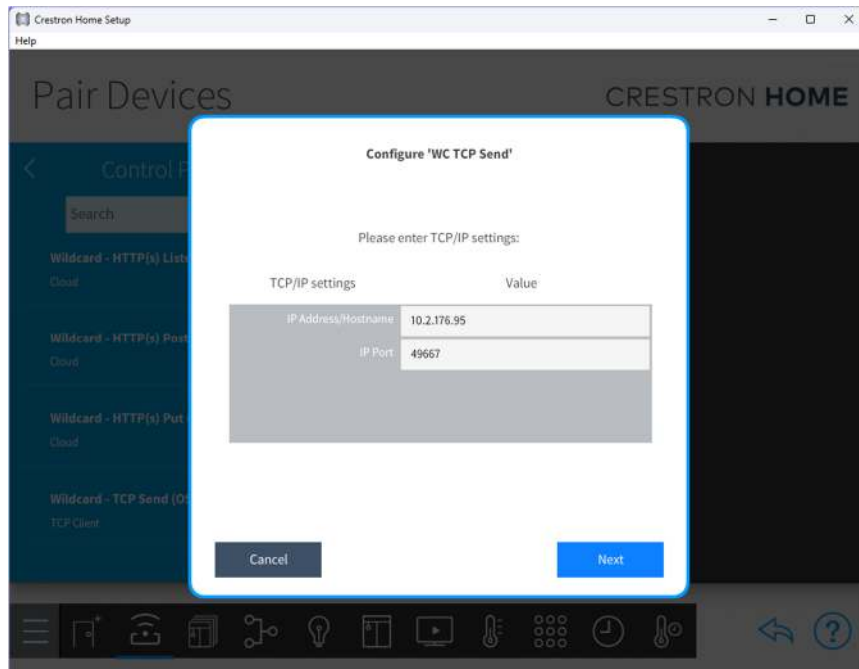
This release note is for the CPLL Wildcard TCP Send Extension. This extension provides up to 10 command strings to communicate to a device via TCP strings.

- This extension requires that the License Manager (<https://cpllc.net/product/license-manager/>) also be installed on the processor.

Installation/Upgrade Instructions



This extension utilizes an TCP connection on a specific port. As such, the first selection on install is the ip address/hostname and port number to use.

Obtain License Key – clicking on the “CPLLC.net” link will take you to the website to purchase the necessary license. The obtained license key will need to be entered in the license manager on the appropriate SKU.

Show on Home Page – check if extension is to be visible on the home page.

Show in Room Page – checked if extension is visible in the room page.

Tile Text – Text that is displayed on the button trigger tile page.

Tile Icon Text – Icon to be used for the main tile. The list of icons can be found [here](#).

Command 01-10 – a specially formatted string is entered here. If the command is not being used, then this field should be left blank.

The formatted Command string consists of 3 parts separated by an “|” (or) bar.

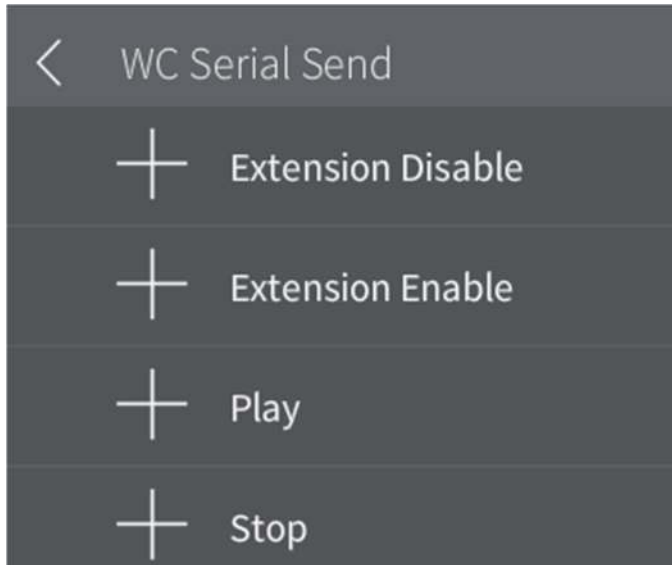
Part 1: Command Text which is displayed on the button.

Part 2: Command Icon which is displayed on the button and the list of available icons can be found [here](#).

Part 3: Payload that would be sent when the button is triggered. An error will be flagged if there are not 3 “|” or bars - if you wish to send binary data you can enter the binary data using the SIMPL entry format of “\xHH” with HH being two hexadecimal values.

Actions

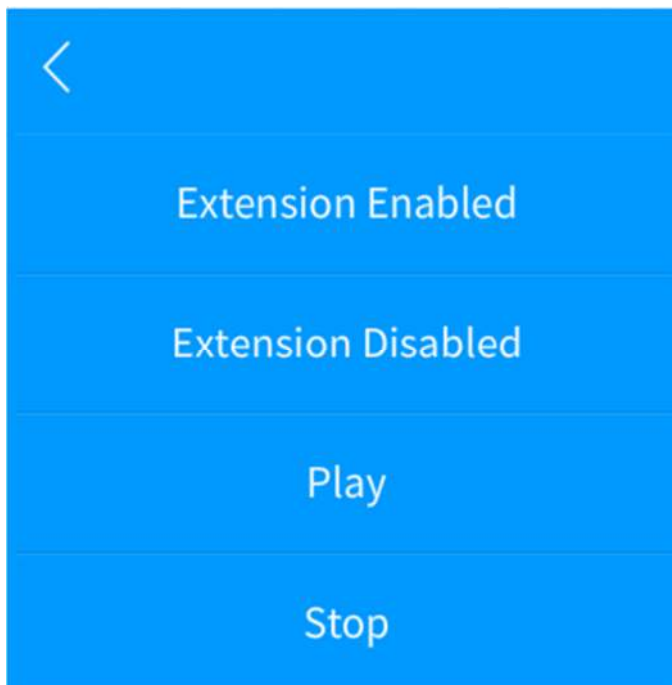


Extension Disable – Used to disable the extension.

Extension Enable – Used to enable the extension.

Commands 01-10 – The commands will be listed with the name specified above. The command text as described above is used.

Events



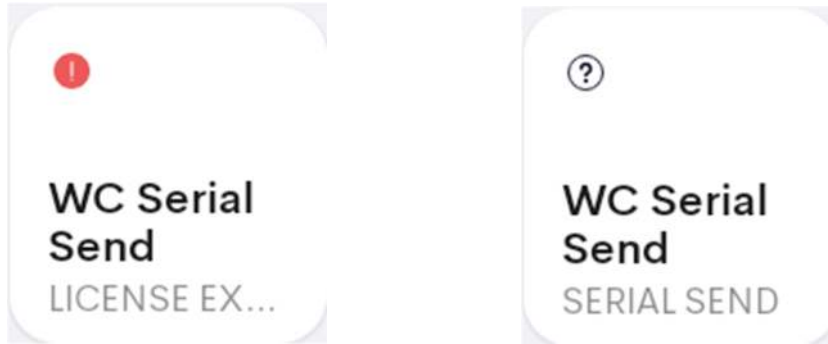
Extension Enabled – extension has been enabled.

Command 01-10 – When the corresponding command is triggered, the corresponding event will be triggered.

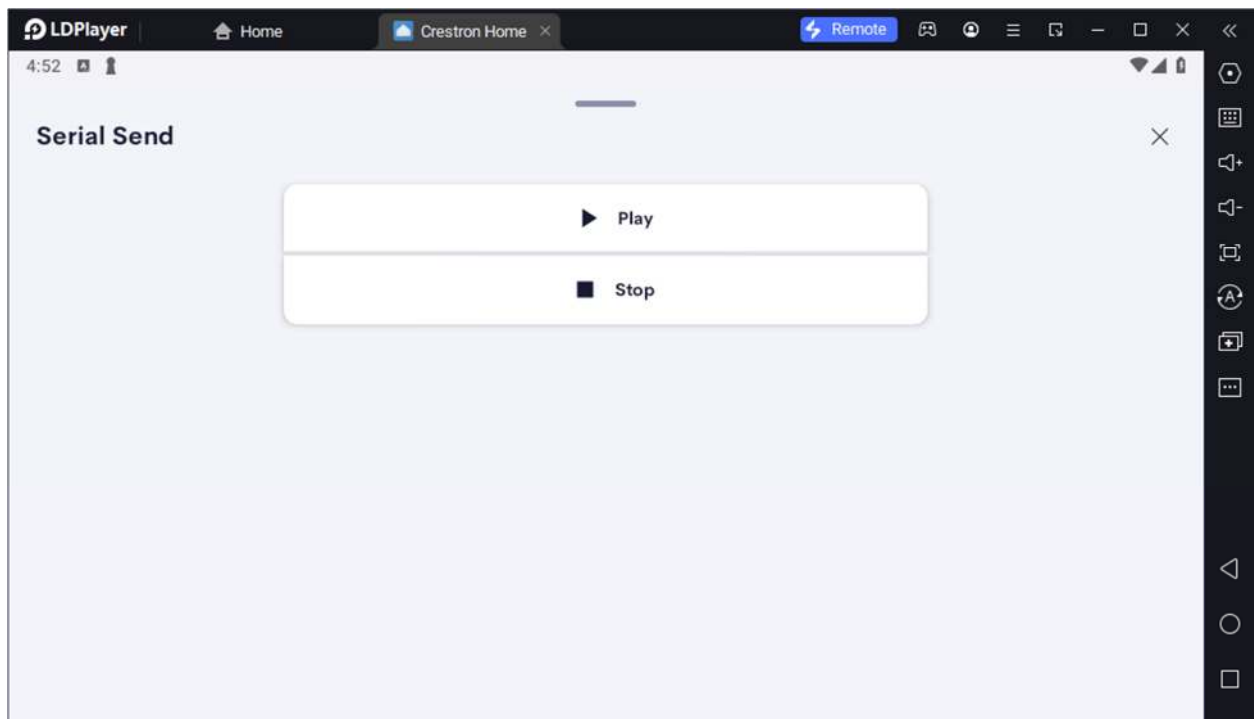
