License Key – this extension requires a paid license key which can be obtained from <https://cpllc.net/?product=ui-tile-keypad-5>. For testing purposes, this extension will function 100% for 2 hours. Rebooting will reset the two hours.

Button 2 Text – Text to be displayed for button 2. Leave blank if not needed.

Button 3 Text – Text to be displayed for button 3. Leave blank if not needed.

Button 4 Text – Text to be displayed for button 4. Leave blank if not needed.

Button 5 Text – Text to be displayed for button 5. Leave blank if not needed.

Button 1 Press – Press button 1

Button 2 Press – Press button 2

Button 3 Press – Press button 3

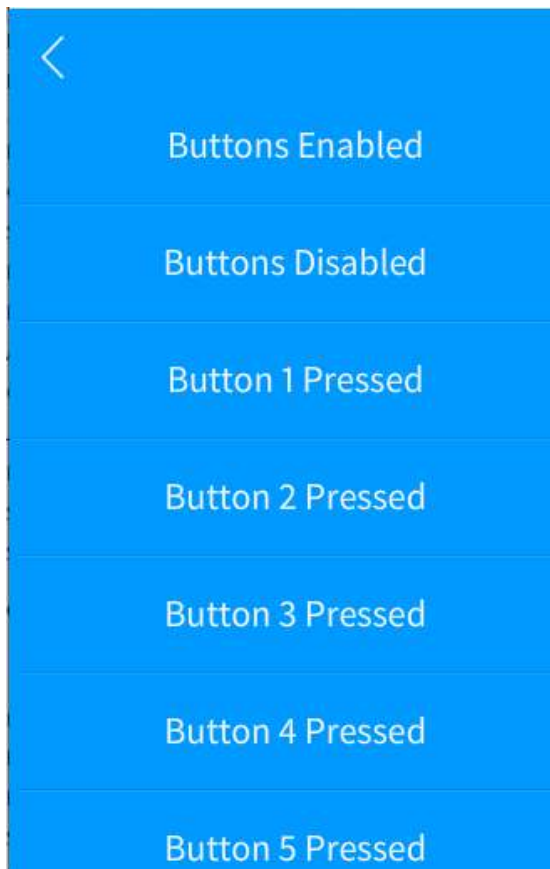
Button 4 Press – Press button 4

Button 1 Pressed – Button 1 was pressed.

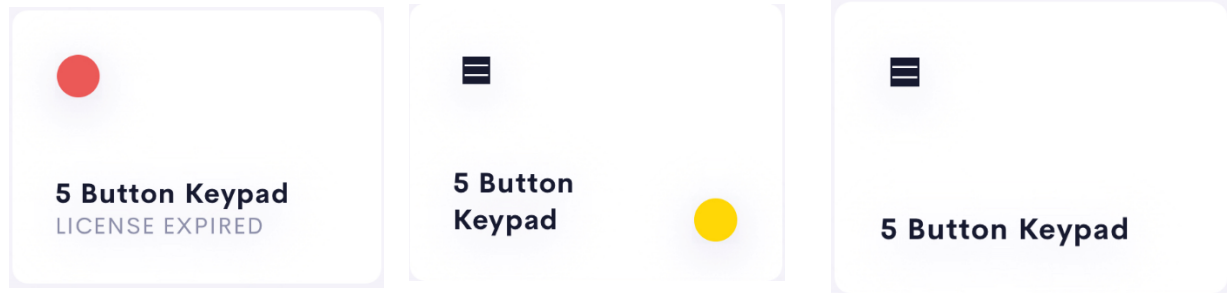
Button 2 Pressed – Button 2 was pressed.

Button 3 Pressed – Button 3 was pressed.

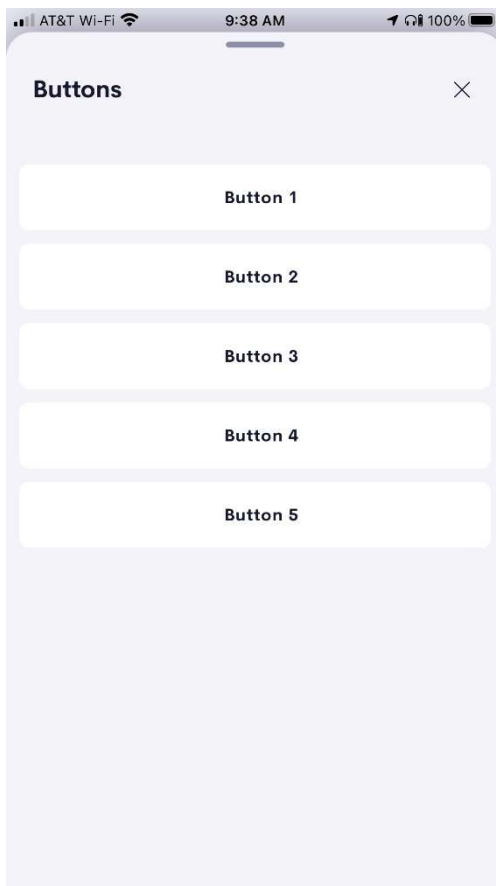
Button 4 Pressed – Button 4 was pressed.

End-User Experience



The above 3 images show the feedback as the keypad goes between license expired, disabled which is shown by the yellow dot, and enabled (left to right)



After the room tile has been touched, the buttons currently configured will be displayed. Touching the button will trigger the associated button event.
